






#### **Observed Precipitation, Inflows vs Historical**


7-day cumulative rainfall





#### **Historical Reservoir Elevation**








#### **Spillway Management – Looking to Winter and Spring**

- SLS discharge currently 40 m<sup>3</sup>/s, and is most likely to be maintained at 40 m<sup>3</sup>/s throughout winter;
- Working through the Smelter load and re-start scenarios
- Ice Jam risk and winter flow protocols collecting data as per NHC recommendation
- Spring Freshet flood risk; Murray Cheslatta System and Vanderhoof




#### **Forecast – Vanderhoof Flows**

 Inflow projections are used to estimate reservoir levels over time considering current hydrology and historically observed additional snow and rain.


